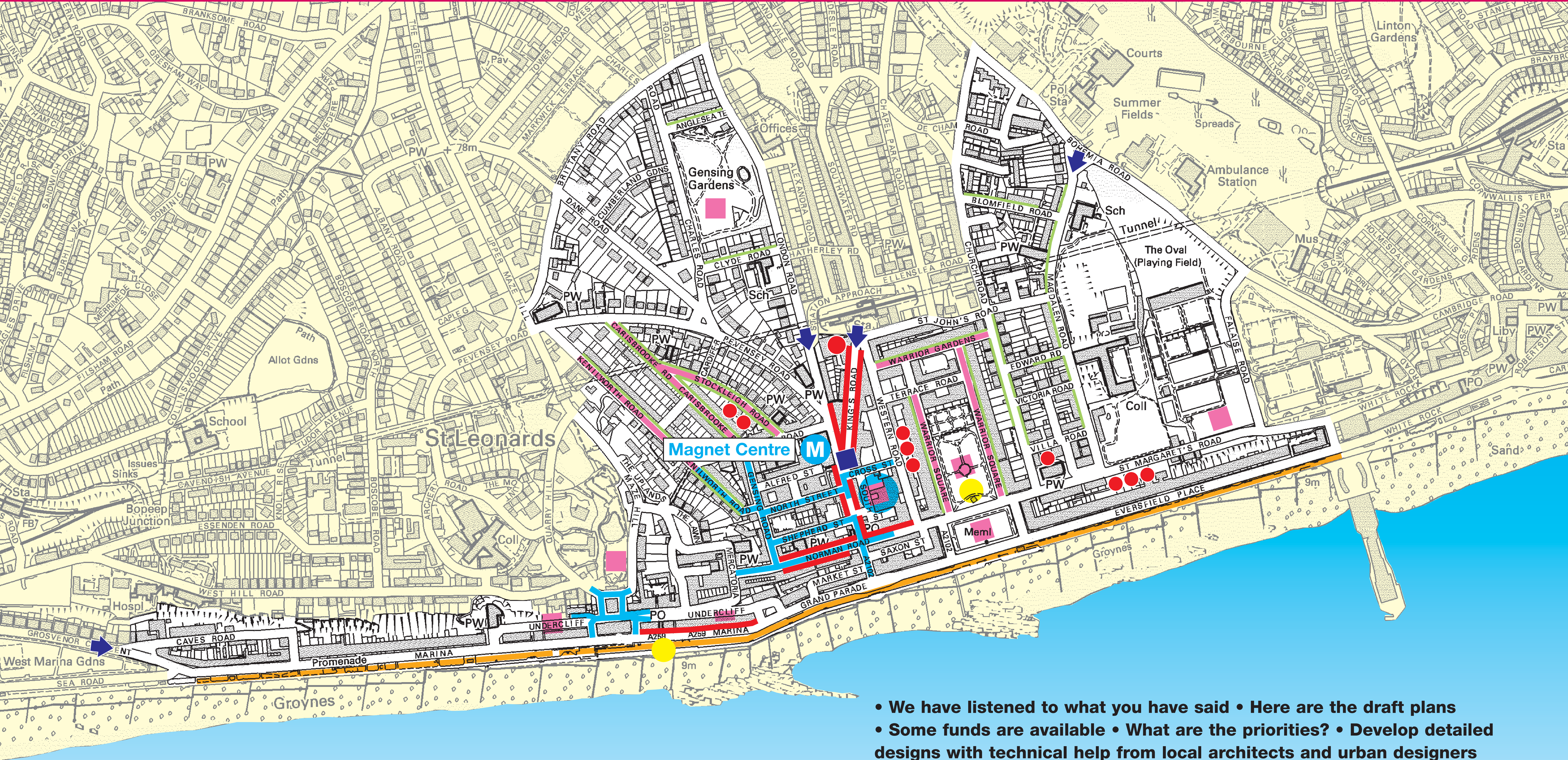


Planning Workshops 19 and 20 September 2003 – All Welcome
