The Small Grants programme provides an opportunity for residents to get funding for their own ideas. Money can be provided to purchase items, deliver services and tackle neighbourhood problems.

Grants of up to £1,066 are available to constituted groups and help can be provided in forming a group. Awards are decided twice a year by a panel of residents. Projects funded to date include Ore Community website (pictured), aGender 'As You Are' young people's project (pictured), conservation walks, seniors' lunch club and Ore Pocket Park.

# This document is a summary of the GREAT Big Local Action Plan for North East Hastings 2017 to 2020

## Why have an Action Plan?

North East Hastings is one of 150 neighbourhoods in the country that have been given £1 million Big Lottery funding to spend over 10 years (2014–24) to make their area an even better place to live. A local resident-led partnership organisation now decides how to spend this money.

An action plan has been drawn up so that everyone can see how the money is being spent. The current plan for the years 2017 to 2020, is based on consultation with local residents and much deliberation by the partnership members. It also builds on the previous plan which covered the period 2014 to 2017.

## Vision

The purpose of this action plan is to help the Big Local area achieve its vision – which is that in 2024, North East Hastings will be a GREAT place to:

- G**row up in
- R**aise a family
- E**njoy life and keep well
- A**dvance in years
- T**rain, learn and earn a living

## Strategy

The Partnership’s approach can be summarised as identifying:

- a** GREAT things we can do ourselves;
- b** GREAT things we can do in partnership with others – some key projects;
- c** GREAT things we can commission from others.
